

# ATTENTION

Evergreen Commons Rehabilitation & Nursing Center is monitoring the community spread of the coronavirus, COVID-19. As of this date Saturday March 20, 2021 there has been no positive case(s) at Evergreen however there are still confirmed cases within neighboring counties and communities.

We want to prevent the potential spread of the coronavirus by restricting individuals who are entering our facility from the community without a scheduled appointment.

All visitors will be restricted from entering Evergreen Commons freely effective March 12, 2020 at 8:00pm until further notice.

Limited and Socially Distant Visitation is by appointment only and will begin Monday March 22, 2021; see Visitation Fact Sheet for details.

Center for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) has issued guidance for all Nursing Homes for limiting the transmission of COVID-19 in Nursing Homes. This guidance directs Nursing Homes to monitor or restrict visitors. Our Nursing Home is following the guidance to prevent transmission of COVID-19 to our residents by Restricting Visitation.

Our staff is being tested for COVID-19 and screened; they will be sent home if there is an indication of illness. If there is a suspicion of symptoms meeting the COVID-19 clinical criteria, we will contact the NYS Department of Health (DOH).

This information is being presented proactively to keep you informed of what we at Evergreen Commons are doing to protect our residents, your loved ones. We will have alternate forms of communication established to ensure you are kept informed and able to continue to participate in your loved ones day to day in the event of stricter visitation.
